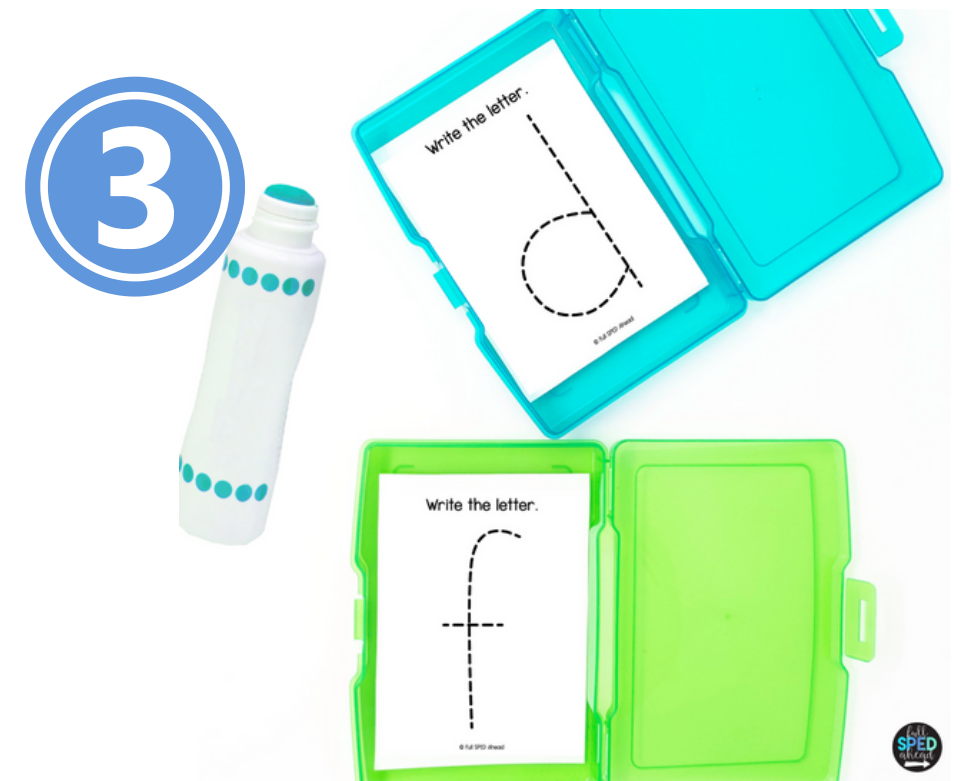
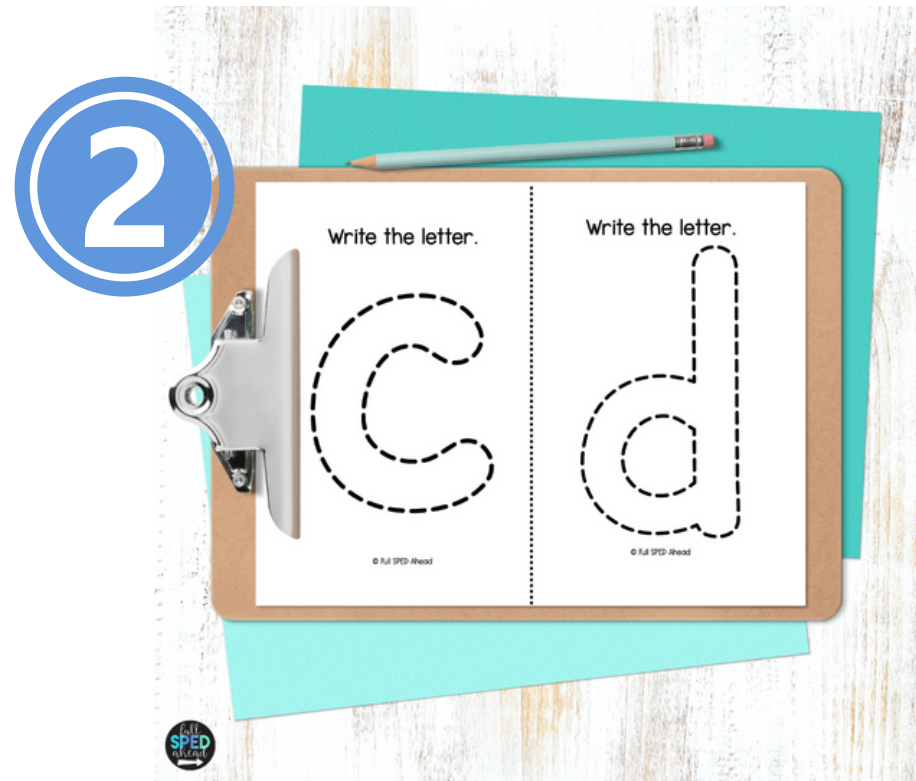
What is included in this resource?
